## VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-5 INTRODUCED BY: SLAIN

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STATE OF OHIO COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act. (AM. Sub. H.B. No. 100), as signed into law on December 4, 1985; and

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provides the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations, regional transit authorities, regional airport authorities or port authorities and school districts, conservancy districts, township park districts and park districts and other authorities, to participate in contracts distributed by the state of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain materials; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, that:

- That the Mayor hereby requests authority in the name of the Village of Bentleyville to participate in state contracts which the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing has entered into and the Office of Cooperative Purchasing has distributed for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain other materials pursuant to
  - Revised Code Section 125.04.
- Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Bentleyville to be bound by all contract terms and conditions as the Department of Administrative Services, Office of Cooperative Purchasing prescribes. Such terms and conditions may include a reasonable annual membership fee to cover the administrative costs which the Department of Administrative Services incurs as a result of Village of Bentleyville participation in the contract. Further, that the Mayor does hereby agree to be bound by all such terms and conditions and to not cause or assist in any way the misuse of such contracts or make contract disclosures to nonmembers of the Coop for the purpose of avoiding the requirements established by ORC 125.04.

That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the Village of Bentleyville to directly pay the vendor, under each such state contract in which it participates for items it receives pursuant to the contract, and the Mayor does hereby agree to directly pay the vendor.

This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason set forth in the preamble hereof, and this Ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval.
