

**VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2012-37  
INTRODUCED BY:**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE 250.12(a) ENTITLED  
"HOSPITALIZATION" AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Bentleyville is desirous of amending Codified Ordinance 250.12(a) entitled Hospitalization.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, the following subsection shall be added to Codified Ordinance 250.12(a).

**Section 1.** That Chapter 250.12(a) of the Village of Bentleyville Codified Ordinances entitled "Hospitalization" which previously read as follows:

250.12 (a) HOSPITALIZATION.

Every full-time employee of the Village is eligible to enroll in the Village group hospitalization plan for either single member or family coverage, depending on his or her status. Spouses of full-time employees shall be required to utilize the health insurance coverage including medical, dental, vision and prescription drug coverage offered to them by their employer or public or private retirement plan. If the spouse's employer or retirement plan does not offer health insurance coverage, the spouse may then utilize the Village's health care plan.

**BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:**

250.12 (a) HOSPITALIZATION

Every full-time employee of the Village is eligible to enroll in the Village group hospitalization plan for either single member or family coverage, depending on his or her status. Spouses of full-time employees shall be required to utilize the health insurance coverage including medical, dental, vision and prescription drug coverage offered to them by their employer or public or private retirement plan. If the spouse's employer or retirement plan does not offer health insurance coverage, the spouse may then utilize the Village's health care plan.


This Ordinance shall apply to all employees hired for full-time employment after March 1, 2012.

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
**Section 2.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason set forth in the preamble hereof, and this Ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval.

**WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date permitted by law.


