AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING GABRIEL BARRONE POLICE CHIEF OF THE VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the current Chief of the Village of Bentleyville is retiring on August 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the Village has interviewed numerous candidates for the position and the Mayor is recommending Gabriel Barrone for Chief.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, Ohio, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council for the Village of Bentleyville hereby confirms Gabriel Barrone as Police Chief of the Village of Bentleyville commencing on September 1, 2013.

Section 2. Council for the Village of Bentleyville hereby authorizes a salary of \$70,000 for Gabriel Barrone and further waives any residency requirement pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 737.15.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason Gabriel Barrone is to commence employment on September 1, 2013.


