

VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE

ORDINANCE NO. 2013-33  
INTRODUCED BY: JOHN BOURISSEAU

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 240.10 ENTITLED "FEE FOR USE OF POLICE VEHICLE," AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Village of Bentleyville may, depending on the circumstances, permit or require the use of a Village police cruiser or other police department vehicle, by a police officer, in the performance of a security detail for private business, private contractors, public entities, utilities or otherwise;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

**Section 1.** The Village hereby enacts Codified Ordinance Section 240.10 to read in its entirety as follows:

**240.10 FEE FOR USE OF POLICE VEHICLE**

There shall be a fee for the use of any police vehicle by any private business, contractor, corporation, public entity, utility, individual, party or entity, regardless of whether the use or presence of the police vehicle is voluntary or required by applicable law. The fee for use of any police vehicle shall be established by Council from time to time.


**Section 2.** The initial fee for use of a police vehicle shall be \$75.00 per 8-hour shift. There shall be no proration of said fee.

**Section 3.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village by establishing a fee structure for use of police vehicles that will provide funds for maintenance and upkeep of the police fleet and compensate the Village funds for the wear and tear on said vehicles; and this resolution shall therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval.


