AN ORDINANCE APPOINTING MARK ONDICH TO FULL-TIME PATROLMAN OF THE VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of Bentleyville has deemed it appropriate to create a position for a full-time patrolman.

WHEREAS, the Village has interviewed numerous internal candidates for the position and the Chief is recommending Mark Ondich for full-time patrolman.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, Ohio, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council for the Village of Bentleyville hereby confirms Mark Ondich as full-time patrolman of the Village of Bentleyville commencing on March 1, 2014.

Section 2. Council for the Village of Bentleyville hereby authorizes a salary of \$44,000.00 for Mark Ondich and further waives any possible residency requirements that may be required pursuant to Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason Mark Ondich is to commence full-time employment on March 1, 2014.




