SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Dale reported the Service Departments request that all debris from the park and cemetery clean-up be gathered and stacked in neat bundles. Any large trees that appear to be dead be marked for removal. Message boards will be delivered to Village Hall. Volunteers will prepare them for display in the village.

OLD BUSINESS

Councilman John Bourisseau will contact Wayne Farinacci to determine the needed seasonal improvements to the Bocce Court. Those improvements will be made by the League members at their expense.

Councilman Ken Kvacek reported that there are now six scouts looking for community service projects. The scouts will earn credits toward their Eagle Scout badges. Ken will advise us of the scouts who select projects in our Village .
