### **SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT**

The Service Department will investigate and repair. The Village Hall beds will be mulched after the Garden Club weeds and plants. Flags for the bridges and the cemetery will be purchased with funds from the Recreation and Beautification fund.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

The Committee reviewed the scheduled Parks events. Ken reported that two new benches will be built by an Eagle Scout. The Village appreciates the work by all the Scouts. The Eagle Scout flower sale ends today, but Ken can still take orders.
