SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- Dale reported that the park's parking lot has been plowed to keep the area accessible. The sledding hill has been used.

OLD BUSINESS

- The Eagle Scouts who have been working on their projects should be contacting us in the near future to have us sign off on their completed work.
- Ken informed the Committee that one Scout who has been cleaning the old school bell found that a portion of it was cast in brass. This discovery will help to more accurately date the bell.
- Ryan was not in attendance, but will be contacted to see if he was able to contact CEI about installing lighting in the park.

NEW BUSINESS

- The parks calendar will be posted on the Village web site as soon as all dates have been confirmed. Discussion was had regarding posting of pick-up for trash, leaves and Christmas trees. Kathleen followed up with Debbie and the trash schedule was posted before the new year, the leaf schedule is posted approximately two weeks prior to that beginning and Christmas tree pick up doesn't have a set date – the Service Department will go around two to three times per week and pick up trees as they find them on the curbs.
- Molly Gebler of the Chagrin Valley Chamber of Commerce has scheduled one concert in the park. We hope they will be able to provide a second concert. She will be getting back to us shortly.
- The Committee will be contacting the Chagrin Watershed Partners to discuss any possible grant funding to improve the parking lot in the Bentleyville Park.
- Ken informed the Committee that Solon is hoping to extend an all-purpose trail to the Aurora branch of the Chagrin River. He will bring more information to our next meeting.
