SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- Dale reported that the park's parking lot has been plowed to keep the area accessible. Dale suggested a picture of children sledding on the Village website to increase use.
- The Committee discussed the need to check the bolts on the pavilion and staining of the structure. This will be addressed in early spring.

OLD BUSINESS

- The Eagle Scout project is progressing. A new picnic table with benches and four Adirondack chairs will be ready in the spring.
- Lighting in the Park is being researched by the Utilities Committee. Alex suggested that solar lighting be researched. We agreed that it is an excellent idea. I will share the idea with the Utilities Committee.

NEW BUSINESS

- The Village has a small budgeted amount for a newsletter. We would like to have a twice yearly letter with additional information posted on the website.
- We briefly discussed the possibility of a grant from the Chagrin Watershed Partners for a parking area in the Park. The weather will be good enough soon.
- Yoga in the Park is scheduled for June and July on Tuesdays at noon.
- Meditation in the Park is being investigated.
- The Village clambake will be chaired by Jeff Widmar and Ken Kvacek.
- Bocce will be organized in time to begin in late May or early June.
- The Parks agenda will be posted on the website by the first of March.
- A NOPEC grant may be available for the Village to host an event. We discussed hosting a band and having a food truck.
- The Committee discussed the need for liability insurance for certain events.
