Meeting was called to order at 10:02 a.m.

Service Directors Report:

- Lloyd informed the committee that the trails in the Park were mowed to keep them clear and comfortably usable.
- The Village tent will be photographed the next time it is used to record its condition.

Old Business:

- The bags provided by the Village seem to be working well. The grassy areas and the trails are free of dog waste.
- The Bocce Court is in very good condition and being used regularly. The fire pit has no wood at this time. Councilman Kvacek asked the Service Director if the department would collect wood along the Village right of way and bring it to the Park.
- Yoga classes have been well attended. The only problem has been rain, forcing the group into the Council chamber.
- The committee has begun discussions about a possible leash law ordinance. The idea will be reviewed at the next meeting. Those in attendance had mixed feeling about the idea.

New Business:

- The band Revolution Pie will perform in the Park on Sunday September 16, 2018 from 4p.m. to 6p.m.
- The Clambake committee will meet in the next week or two. It was suggested that the Village tent be erected and the tables be set up as well. The date of the event is October 20, 2018, starting at 5p.m.
