## APPLIANCE TURN-IN PROGRAM

**FirstEnergy's Ohio utilities will pick up and recycle your old refrigerator or freezer and you'll get \$50.**

Getting rid of your old fridge or freezer couldn't be easier. We'll pick up and recycle your old fridge or freezer and you'll get \$50. Plus you can save up to \$150 a year in reduced energy costs. Recycle a working room air conditioner or dehumidifier along with a qualifying refrigerator or freezer and you'll get an **additional \$25** per unit.

### Program Guidelines

- Must be an electric customer of FirstEnergy's Ohio utilities
- You must own the appliance(s)
- Refrigerators and freezers must be 10-30 cu.ft., plugged in, and operating (cooling) at the time of the scheduled pickup
- Limit of two refrigerators/freezers plus up to two room air conditioners/dehumidifiers per calendar year
- Your incentive will be mailed to you within four weeks after pickup of appliance(s)
