

VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO: 2019-29
INTRODUCED BY: GOETSCH

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 2015-29 TO REFLECT THE REPEALING OF TITLE FOUR, CHAPTER 880 OF THE BENTLEYVILLE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND TO CORRECT THE TAX CREDIT FROM 25% TO .25% AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Bentleyville passed Ordinance 2015-29 which created Chapter 890 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Bentleyville regarding Municipal Income Tax; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village, with the passage of Ordinance 2015-29, explicitly intended that Title Four, Chapter 880 of the Bentleyville Codified Ordinances be repealed; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village has determined that a typographical error appeared in Section 6(A) of Ordinance 2015-29 in that the tax credit shall not exceed .25% not 25%

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village finds it is within the best interests of the Village to amend Ordinance 2015-29 by including language that Title Four, Chapter 880 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village be repealed and that the typographical error in Section 6(A) be corrected to reflect tax credit shall not exceed .25% not 25%.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, Ohio, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council for the Village passed Ordinance 2015-29 which created Chapter 890 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Bentleyville regarding Municipal Income Tax. It was the explicit intent of Council that Title Four Chapter 880 of the Codified Ordinances for the Village of Bentleyville be repealed. Therefore, Title Four Chapter 880 is hereby repealed.


Section 2. Section 6(A) of Ordinance 2015-29 contained a typographical error in that the tax credit shall not exceed .25% not 25%; and, therefore, the Ordinance is hereby amended to reflect that the tax credit shall not exceed .25%.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance

with all legal requirements including the applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code.


Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village.


