Dear Resident of Quartermane Circle or Pheasant Ct.:

The pavement replacement work will resume with saw cutting this week and pavement removal starting Monday March 23rd.

The Stage 2 area (blue area on the attached map) will be the work area, with the inside, or even address side being done first. As with last year, each side should take 3 weeks to complete, so the pavement replacement work will be done by May 15th, with the remaining restoration done by Memorial Day. All of this is based on having good weather. Extended rain will delay the completion.

Please be aware of the one-way traffic direction shown on the attached Staging Map that will be in effect. The one-way direction (clockwise) will be in effect for the Stage 2 area. The areas that have been completed on Stages 1 and 3 will remain 2-way traffic.

All areas will have the landscape restoral completed when weather permits

DRIVEWAY ACCESS

During the work on your side of the street, we anticipate driveway access to be blocked for 3 weeks. When the work is being done on your side of the street, you will not have access to your driveway with your vehicle. We suggest that you talk to your neighbor across the street to ask for permission to park your vehicle(s) in their drive during the work period when your drive is not accessible. Cooperation among all the residents is the key to making this period the least inconvenience as possible. You may also park on the sections of the roadway where the work is not occurring, in the other stages, parking on the street in the work areas is prohibited, as it will block the street.

SPECIAL NEEDS/LANDSCAPING SERVICES/GARBAGE PICK UP

If you have special needs due to health reasons or have deliveries scheduled that require access to your driveway during the time the road is being worked on, please contact the Village Engineer at the number below, or by email. If you have landscaping service or other service providers, please let them know that they cannot park in the street in front of your home. Also, if you would like updates on the project via email, please email the Village Engineer at the address below.

Your trash and recyclables will be picked up on the normal pickup day

MAIL

Since the mail delivery person cannot reach the mailboxes during construction, a gang mailbox center will be setup for Stage 2 residents. Please see the attached map for the location of the gang mailbox center on the west side of the Lake near the parking area. It will be in the same area as last year.

SPRINKLER SYSTEMS/INVISIBLE PET FENCES


The tree lawns will be cut back from the curb approximately 2 feet to allow for the paving machine. If you have lawn sprinkler system or buried pet fence wiring within 3 feet of the curb, please have it marked. The Contractor will do their best to avoid damaging it, so it is important that it is marked. Please note that the Village and the Contractor are not responsible for repairing these systems in the public Right of Way. After the tree lawns are seeded, please water the seeded areas so the grass will grow.

As the project progresses, you will be receiving further notifications from the Village or the Contractor regarding starting work in the next area that will affect access and traffic patterns.

An inspector from Quality Control Inspection (QCI) will be on site during the project. If you have any questions, please feel free to talk with him. His name is Mike Artino.
