Service Directors Report:

Lloyd has tried to reach the company that replaced the Village Hall roof. He has not heard back but will try again to reach the owner. The leak may be caused by a gap in the flashing.

Work on the clean-up at the Service Garage is progressing.

Old Business:

The new Salt bin should be installed by the end of June. We await the cover to be made and delivered.

The Law Director will review our lease with the Metropark for the Service Garage.

The committee discussed the proposed all-purpose trail that the Metropark is proposed. The Metropark has applied for a Grant to build this trail. If the Grant is approved the trail will go through Bentleyville Park. Our Mayor has sent a letter of support for the Grant. The ramifications of an all-purpose trail to our Park were discussed. We need to consider the changes that would occur as a result of an all-purpose trail. The committee will further discuss our thoughts and options.

New Business:

Social distancing in the Park was discussed. A reminder sign will be posted as we open. We are hoping to keep most of our planned events with reminders of social distancing.

The cemetery needs clean up. Lloyd said that the Service Department will take care of the necessary work.

The NOPEC Grant of \$500.00 has been received. It will be used for our concert or another Village event, if the concert must be canceled.
Village Hall beds will be mulched in the near future.

The contract for fertilizing the Crab Apple trees will not be renewed next year. The trees are sufficiently developed and our budget will be tight.
