ORDINANCE NO: 2020-44
INTRODUCED BY: GOETSCH

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KIMBLE RECYCLING & WASTE DISPOSAL BEING THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDDER, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Mayor has heretofore been authorized and directed by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville to advertise for bids for a **Three Year Contract for Refuse Collection, Disposal and Recycling Program**, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor has caused said advertisement to be made, and has received, opened and tabulated bids and report the same to Council in order that the Council may determine the lowest and best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio:

Section 1: That the Council hereby finds and determines that said advertisement was duly made according to law for the hereinabove described purchase, that bids have been received, opened and tabulated and reported to Council, and that Council after due consideration thereof does hereby find and determine the BID by Kimble Recycling & Waste Disposal to be the lowest and best bid submitted, that the said bid is hereby accepted and that the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with the said company for the base cost of \$18.47 per month per residence in year one, \$19.02 per month per residence in year two and \$19.59 per month per residence in year three.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.


