The Mayor also noted that Waste Management has picked up their cans. There were a number of resident calls regarding the trash can collection and distribution despite the resident letters mailed by Kimble. Many people did not get their mail due to reasons such as being out of town and the mail back up. To better communicate with residents in the future, the Mayor noted that Council Member Kvacek suggested changing the contract end date to avoid the holidays.

Mayor Spremulli wanted to commend residents Steve and Loree Potash who made a \$7.5 million donation to University Hospitals Ahuja Medical Center to establish a center for women and newborns.

Mayor Spremulli has not received an answer from the Metroparks regarding the service garage lease. As they are considering their options, the mayor noted that Bentleyville will need to also consider our options. If we do not hear from the Metroparks soon, the Mayor will set up a subcommittee to address the issue.
