Service Directors Report

- The Village one tent and thirteen folding tables those are available for use by Bentleyville residents. A reservation is needed to secure these items for use in the park or on a resident's property. The tent requires a \$300 nonrefundable deposit. The folding tables require a \$50 dollar refundable deposit for use.
- The Village no longer has a working grill.
- Road side clean-up has been requested. The county is currently beginning this program.
- Power in the Park Pavilion has not yet been restored. Estimates are being sought.
- The Service Department has begun the clean-up of large limbs and debris.
- An estimate to repair the cupola leak at Village Hall has been accepted in the amount of \$10,840.00. The work will be scheduled shortly.
- The new sign naming the Village Park is in progress and will be completed and mounted in the near future.

Old Business

- The Service Department has fertilized the grass at Village Hall. They also repaired the grass in front of the flag pole.
- The NOPEC Grant of \$500 will be given to the Village through the Garden Club of Bentleyville. The club has agreed to host and pay for a holiday event for the Village using the NOPEC Grant monies.
- Observation guides for the Park are available on the Ohio Department of Natural Resources web site. We will print copies and make them available in the Park.
- No further information is available concerning the Service Garage lease.
