Fiscal Officers Report

- ACCOUNTS PAYABLE: Nickol distributed and reviewed the accounts payable for the month.
 - Expenditures of \$258,606.99 were reviewed and approved by the committee.
- 2. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS: Nickol provided a review of the statements that were previously distributed. The financial statements were reviewed and approved. Income is up over prior year and expenses are lower than budgeted.
- INCOME EXPECTATIONS: Nickol presented the YTD RITA income that was provided by RITA. December receipts were \$67,107.00. The income from RITA is 23.86% higher than prior year to date 2020. YTD income is \$1,226,966. RITA income is \$236,397 over the prior YTD.

Old Business:

- RITA initiative regarding non or late filers. RITA recommended we participate in subpoena program in 2022. We had no update from RITA on collections.
- American Rescue Plan Act of 2021. The grant of \$88,619.40 is identified for the Village. Expenses to be paid by fund include is North Fork Storm Water repairs \$7,000, Miles rd storm water replacement \$76,000, and storm drainage wall replacement on Holbrook \$17,000.
