RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A FIRST AMENDMENT TO LEASE AGREEMENT WITH CLEVELAND METROPARKS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council deems it in the best interest to enter into the First Amendment to Lease Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE, COUNTY OF CUYAHOGA AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1: That the Mayor is authorized to enter into a First Lease Amendment a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference as Exhibit "A", on behalf of the Village.
- Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Bentleyville and for the further reason set forth in the preamble hereof, and this Resolution shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval.
