Service Directors Report:

- The flagpole renovations cannot be completed this year. The improvements will be done in the spring of 2023 and funded thru the 2023 budget at an approximate \$5,500 cost.
- The garage doors of the police department need replacing. No cost effective options have been found.
- Village Hall grounds have been improved. The continuing work will occur in the spring.

Old Business:

- The millstone obtained for the Village by Councilman Kvacek, will be set after study by a committee. The placement will occur in the spring.
- The water line in the park has not been repaired. Grant monies will be used for the repair. This will be part of park improvements including the addition of a rest room.

New Business:

- The Clambake is not confirmed at this time.
- Booville is being planned for October 23rd. Mike Neumanitis has agreed to set up the spooky trail. He will not be able to attend. Councilman Kvacek will get pumpkins for painting. A police vehicle and service department truck will be available for the children to explore. Treats will be available. Other plan will be made for the event.
- Santa and Mrs. Claus are committed to visiting the Holiday Lighting Ceremony. Garden Club will be asked to serve juice and cookies. Garden Club will be decorating Village Hall prior to the event.
