REVIEW OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES

No minutes from the July 2023 meeting were available for review and approval. Councilman Rubin provided an update at the July Council Meeting, as shown in those minutes.

SERVICE DIRECTOR'S REPORT

The service director reported that everything is going well with the service department. All equipment is working properly and is ready for leaf season. All salt has now been delivered, so we have about 500 tons in storage. Taking delivery also the Village to avoid storage fees from the supplier. The chipper, which is too small and light duty to be very useful, will be offered for sale on deals.gov. The service department will continue to use the large dumpsters for branch disposal. The decision was made to retain the small Kubota tractor because it has proven to be more useful than expected. A new sickle bar is on order, which should allow for better roadside trimming. Chagrin Falls will sewer jet two catch basins on Chagrin River Road, at no cost.

CHIEF OF POLICE REPORT

The Chief was not available for the meeting. Ms. Papa reported that there have been no scheduling issues lately with full and part time officers. The recently purchased MDT units have been installed, but not yet activated. The Fiscal Officer is continuing to monitor the safety budget after the addition of a full-time officer, and we should know in the next few months what, if any, budget amendment may be needed to address that change.
