AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARTICIPATION IN A JOINT ROAD PROJECT WITH THE VILLAGE OF MORELAND HILLS FOR THE RESURFACING OF CHAGRIN RIVER ROAD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Moreland Hills requested participation by the Village of Bentleyville in the resurfacing of Chagrin River Road which is located partly in Bentleyville and partly in Moreland Hills; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Moreland Hills and the Village of Bentleyville have agreed on allocating and sharing of cost for the Chagrin River Road resurfacing project, and it has been estimated that the total costs of the Bentleyville portion of the resurfacing project, including estimated and inspection fees, is Thirty Seven Thousand Dollars and 00/100 (\$37,000.00) as reviewed and recommended by the Village Engineer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, State of Ohio:

- Section 1.** The Council for the Village of Bentleyville finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the Village to participate with the Village of Moreland Hills in the resurfacing of Chagrin River Road.
- Section 2.** The Village of Bentleyville is hereby authorized to participate in the joint resurfacing project with the Village of Moreland Hills for the resurfacing of Chagrin River Road in the amount of Thirty-Seven Thousand Dollars (\$37,000.00) based on analysis of the quantity of materials, engineering, and inspection fees that are allocable to the Village of Bentleyville's portion of Chagrin River Road.
- Section 3.** The Fiscal Officer is authorized to appropriate to a proper account a sum sufficient to cover the cost of the Village of Bentleyville's share of the Chagrin River Road Resurfacing Project as authorized in Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance.
- Section 4.** It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
- Section 5.** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the inhabitants of the Village, and for the further reason set forth in the preamble hereof, and this Ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval.
