AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SUBSECTION (h) OF SECTION 416.05 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES FOR THE VILLAGE OF BENTLEYVILLE DELETING THE REQUIREMENT THAT PEDESTRIANS UPON A ROADWAY SHALL YIELD THE RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ALL VEHICLES UPON THE ROADWAY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended that Council repeal Subsection (h) of Section 416.05, Walking, Jogging or Running on Sidewalks and Streets, of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Bentleyville; and

WHEREAS Council desires to make such amendment and to repeal Subsection (h) of Section 416.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Bentleyville.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio:

- Subsection (h) of Section 416.05, Walking, Jogging or Running on Sidewalks and Streets, is hereby repealed.
  - (h) Except as otherwise provided in Sections 414.03 and 416.01, any pedestrian upon a roadway shall yield the right of way to all vehicles upon the roadway.
- Section 2. That any Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
- Section 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to this legislation were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 208.04 of the Codified Ordinances for the Village of Bentleyville and Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village of Bentleyville and for the further reason that the Village of Bentleyville wants to immediately repeal Subsection (h) of Section 416.05 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Bentleyville. This Ordinance shall, therefore, take effect and be in full force immediately from and after the date of its passage and approval.
