RESOLUTION NO: 2024-32

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NATIONAL FIRST EQUIPMENT LLC, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$32,500.00 FOR A TRACTOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Bentleyville has entered into a cooperative purchasing program with the State of Ohio to participate in State contracts with the Department of Administrative Services, Office of State purchasing, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment and certain material pursuant to ORC §125.04;

WHEREAS, the cooperative purchasing programs, after public bidding, will determine the vendor that is the best vendor(s) for equipment. However, the Village can purchase supplies, services and equipment from another party upon equivalent terms, conditions and specifications but at a lower price than it can through Cooperative Purchasing Program with the State of Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the tractor with a bucket that the Village uses to transfer salt from the salt bay to trucks is broken;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that a purchase of a used tractor with bucket and other attachments is need for the protection of the employees of the Service Department;

WHEREAS, National First Equipment LLC has submitted a purchase order for the purchase of a used John Deere Model 310SG front-end loader (“Tractor”); and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that National First Equipment LLC purchase order is the lowest and best price for the used Tractor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with National First Equipment in an amount not to exceed \$32,500.00 for the purchase of the Tractor.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including the applicable sections of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the


