**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT
WITH SPECIALIZED CONSTRUCTION FOR
THE 2024 ASPHALT PAVEMENT REPAIRS
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS Specialized Construction has submitted a bid to the Village for the 2024 Asphalt Pavement Repairs in an amount not to exceed \$50,630.00.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that Specialized Construction is the lowest and best bidder for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bentleyville, County of Cuyahoga, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Specialized Construction in an amount not to exceed \$50,630.00 for the 2024 Asphalt Pavement Repairs.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the inhabitants of the Village and for the further reason that it is necessary to reconcile the final amounts.
